### BEFORE USING FOR THE FIRST TIME

Please ensure you read and understand these instructions clearly before using this product for the first time. Failure to do so could result in personal injury or damage to this product or property. It is important you retain this user manual for future reference.

### SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- ▶ Do not use the work light in the immediate vicinity of inflammable materials or gases.
- ▶ Make sure that the light is not covered during use.
- ▶ Only use the accessories included with this product when charging the work light.
- ▶ Keep this work light out of reach of children and pets.
- ▶ Do not point the light directly in your own, any other person's or animals eyes.
- ▶ Always check the cable before charging. If the cable or any part of the charger is damaged, replace with a like for like spare.

### RECHARGING

- ▶ Ensure the battery is fully charged before using the work light for the first time.
- ▶ It is important for the work light to be charged every three months to maintain the optimum condition of the battery.
- ▶ The battery charge status can be determined by reading the battery charge indicator. Once this indicator is fully lit, the light is charged.

### CLEANING

Use a soft cloth or cotton swab with water to clean the lens. Care should be taken during cleaning. Allow the work light to completely dry before using. Do not use any harsh chemicals or abrasive materials when cleaning, as this may damage the light.

### DISPOSAL OF THIS PRODUCT

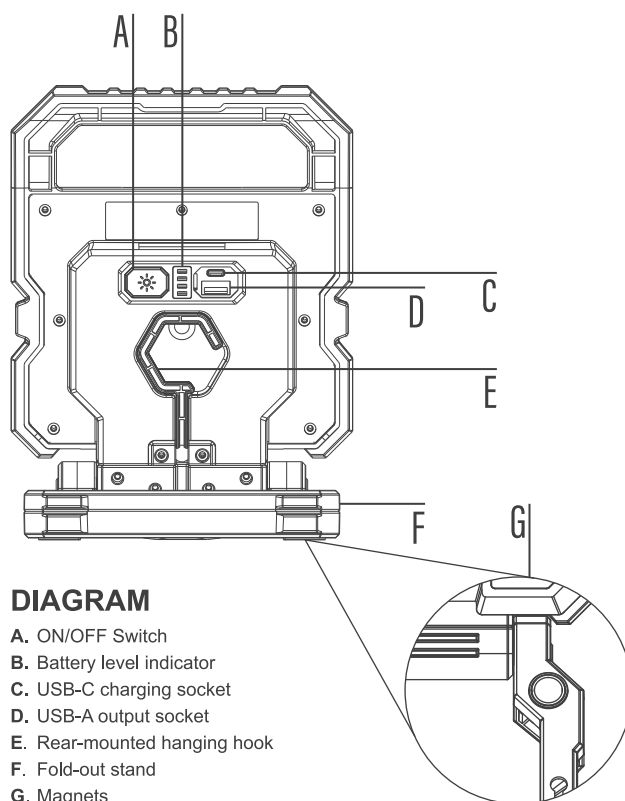

### OPERATING FUNCTIONS

This work light cycles through four operating functions by continuously pressing the **on/off** button.

- ▶ 1st press: ON (Full Brightness)
- ▶ 2nd press: 50% Output (Half Brightness)
- ▶ 3rd press: 25% Output (Quarter Brightness)
- ▶ 4th press: OFF

- B. Battery level indicator
- C. USB-C charging socket
- D. USB-A output socket
- E. Rear-mounted hanging hook
- F. Fold-out stand

### GUARANTEE

Rechargeable battery life depends on many factors and the cells can become easily damaged, dependent on environmental and storage conditions. Your product is guaranteed from defect for a period of **1 year**, this excludes the battery which is covered for 90 days from the date of purchase, if you notice the running or charge times decreasing this is normal over the lifetime of the battery and is classed as fair wear and tear.

There will be some items within our range which will be non-serviceable but, in most cases we can supply replacement batteries for our products.
