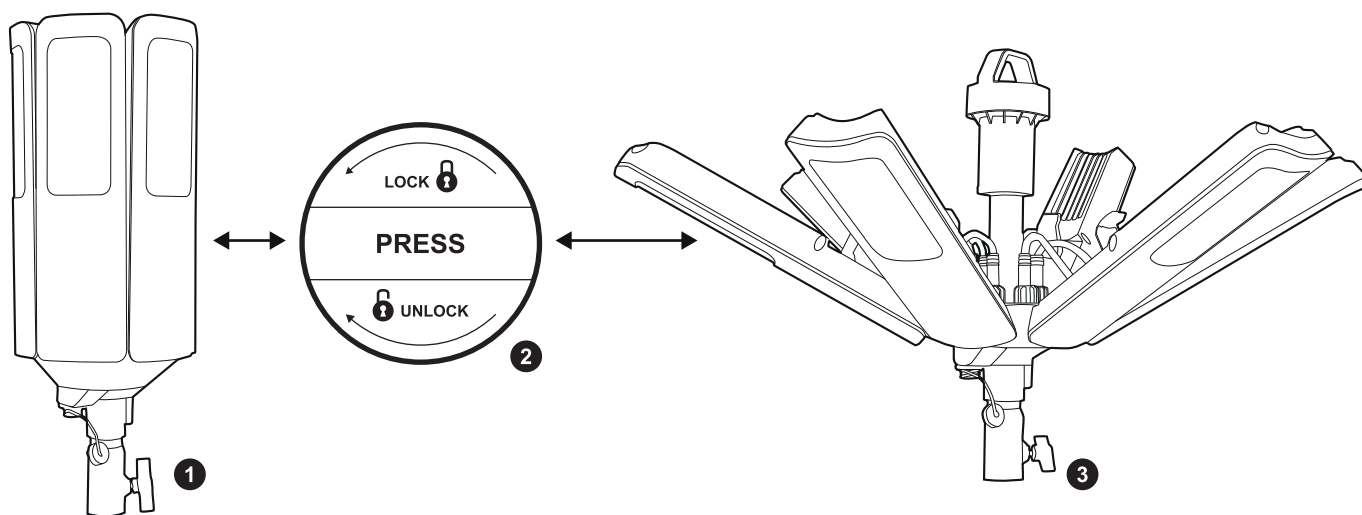
BEFORE USING FOR THE FIRST TIME

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

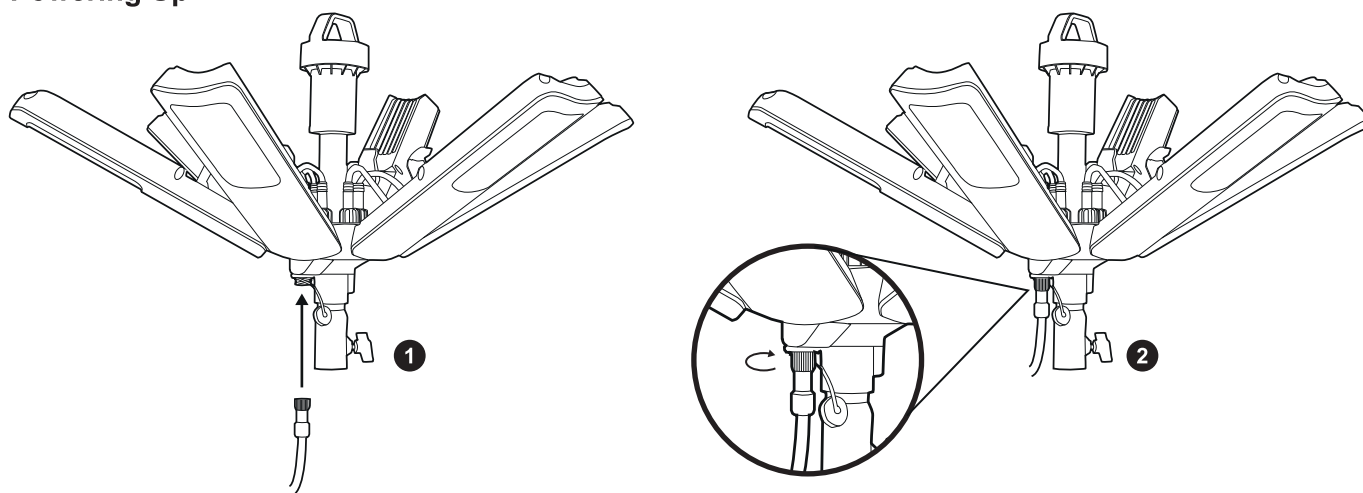
- ▶ Do not use the site light in the immediate vicinity of inflammable materials or gases.
- ▶ Make sure that the light lens is not covered during use.
- ▶ Do not use this site light if any part is damaged.
- ▶ Keep the site light out of reach of children and pets.
- ▶ Do not point the beam directly in your own, any other person's or animals eyes.
- ▶ Always check the mains cable before using the site light. If any part appears damaged, do not use until repaired by a qualified technician. If any repair has been carried out by unauthorised personnel, it may void any warranty associated with this product.
- ▶ Always check that the voltage displayed on the product is the same as the mains power source.
- ▶ Never use an electrical appliance in the rain, in wet areas or with wet hands. Using an electrical appliance under these conditions greatly increases the possibility of electric shock.

Locking & Unlocking



1. To lock and unlock the lamp from its 45 and 90 degree positions, depress the grab handle at the top of the unit (**Figure 2**) and twist anti-clockwise to lock and clockwise to unlock.

Powering Up

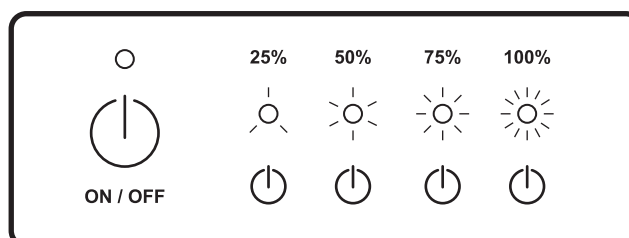


2. To power up the light, first attach the power cable by plugging the connector into the socket at the base of the light's head (**Figure 1**).

Once attached, fasten the end of the cable (**Figure 2**) to ensure a safe and reliable connection is made and maintained.

3. Once the power cable is connected, plug the Driver unit into a standard mains socket and press the **ON / OFF** button on the control panel. To achieve different light output modes, press the desired light output percentage button located on the control panel.

CLEANING

Before cleaning the LED floodlight, disconnect the power cable and allow the floodlight to cool down sufficiently. Clean with a dry or slightly moist, clean, lint-free cloth and a mild detergent if required. Do not use cleaning solutions that contain abrasives or solvents.

MAINTAINENCE

Check the plug, power cable and housing of the LED floodlight for damage before each use. If the lens is damaged it must be replaced immediately.

Clean any dirt from the housing or lens immediately since it could cause overheating.

*CRI

Colour Rendering Index (CRI) is the measurement of how colours look under a light source when compared with sunlight. The index is measured from 0-100, with a perfect 100 indicating that colours under the light source appear the same as they would under natural sunlight.
